

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFIT INFORMATION

If you have to quit your job due to domestic violence, you may be eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits.

The law requires that your need to quit be directly caused by domestic violence and your belief that your continued employment would jeopardize your safety or the safety of your immediate family.

Recent documentation of the domestic violence is required in the form of an active or recently issued *protective order*, other court order, or a *police record*.

You may file a claim for unemployment insurance benefits by using the Internet at:
