PARTNERS WORKING TOGETHER

Local Domestic Violence Programs and the Statewide Coalition

Maryland's local domestic violence programs work in partnership with the Maryland Network Against Domestic Violence (MNADV), the statewide coalition, to meet the complex and challenging needs of domestic violence victims and their families. The programs and the coalition form complimentary and interconnected links in a chain that provides a coordinated community response. Working together, we promote victim safety, abuser accountability, and lives free from abuse. By building a powerful, collaborative advocacy effort, we impact policies and laws that affect victims and abusers.

When Victims Need Protection from Abuse:

The Local Domestic Violence Program accompanies them to court, helps them apply for a protection or peace order, and assists them in navigating the legal system.

The Statewide Coalition – MNADV advocates with state and federal legislators to improve protective and peace order laws and to strengthen the enforcement of existing laws.

When Victims Need Help to Lead Lives Safe from Abuse:

The Local Domestic Violence Program provides 24 hour hotline, emergency shelter, counseling for victims and abusers, advocacy, and other services to promote safety and self-sufficiency for victims and their families.

The Statewide Coalition – MNADV advocates for funding for local domestic violence programs; provides referrals to local programs; offers training and technical assistance to enhance the knowledge and skills of program staff; and develops standards and promotes best practices and model programs in service provision.

When Victims Need the Intervention of the Criminal Justice System:

The Local Domestic Violence Program collaborates with local law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, and court personnel to improve victim safety and abuser accountability, and participates in the Lethality Assessment Program.

The Statewide Coalition – MNADV advocates for systems change in the criminal justice system at the statewide level, and develops and implements programs, policies, and protocols with accompanying training on programs such as The Lethality Assessment Program—The Maryland Model, law enforcement training, and model programs on strangulation and high risk offenders.

When Victims Need a Community Coordinated Response:

The Local Domestic Violence Program collaborates and partners with community partners to improve their outreach and referral sources; and participates on Domestic Violence Fatality Review Teams and domestic violence coordinating councils to identify ways to improve outcomes for victims in the future.

The Statewide Coalition – MNADV provides training and technical assistance to professionals from a diversity of fields and organizations to improve their response to victims; and provides training and technical assistance to local Domestic Violence Fatality Review Teams to formulate recommendations.

When Victims Need Greater Public Awareness of Domestic Violence:

The Local Domestic Violence Program delivers outreach and training to community organizations, local media, faith groups, local businesses, survivors, and concerned citizens to expand awareness of domestic violence.

The Statewide Coalition – MNADV disseminates information about domestic violence, designs and distributes public awareness materials, and communicates with the media and through the website and social networks.
