Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

- Updating the MNADV website, including optimizing it for SEO (Search Engine Optimization)

Requirements:

- A strong commitment to social justice and to ending violence against women
- Active participation and experience with social media platforms (Instagram, Snapchat, Facebook, Twitter, Pinterest, Tumblr, YouTube)
- Able to commit to at least 8-10 hours per week for a minimum of 12 weeks at our office in Lanham, MD
- Experience in graphic design, video editing, SEO, or email marketing a plus

- Work in an office environment where you'll gain project management skills that are important in any career.
- Combine classroom knowledge with the practical challenges of day-to-day project implementation.

- Learn about the services available to support survivors of domestic violence in Maryland.
- Attend trainings about domestic violence for free taught by experts in the field.
